- Established 2002
- AIMS:-
- reduce need for SCBU admissions
- resuscitation nurses' posts
- Spread scheme nationwide

- 6 resuscitation nurses in post
- Admissions to SCBU down from 23% to 8%

THE HOSPICE AT HOME SCHEME

- Funded by Elton John Foundation
- For AIDS orphans and their carers
- Supervision
- Nutrition
- Medication
- Sensitisation





HOSPICE AT HOME SCHEME



- Works in collaboration with PIDC
- Supervision-height ,weight etc
- Food and medicines
- Supervise HAART
- Prophylaxis- Septrin etc



H-a-H Scheme - current situation

- KAMPALA-
- 280 Families
- Monthly visits

- KAYUNGA
- 15 Families visited
- 50 'on the books"
- Potential case load 400+

THE FUTURE



- No new schemes to be started
- HAART gives longevity, so changing needs
- 400 School fee grants obtained
- How best to use of CAI land ?
- Press Govt on Resus
- Press Govt on Mothercare

“MOTHERCARE” SCHEME



- Provides “hotel services”
- Cares for abandoned neonates(1 carer) and older children(2).
- Government to take over ?
- Demand increasing- some mothers abuse the scheme







PLAY THERAPY SCHEME



- 50-100 children
- Qualified teacher/psychologist
- Acute Illness - if they are well enough to play, fit for discharge
- Long-stay - keep up with the “three Rs”



A LOST GENERATION

- 15% of the population are HIV +ve
- Few males age 15-40 survive
- Those who do are nearly all HIV+ve
- Many women die leaving large families
- Their younger children are HIV+ve
- Grannies are the carers . (19 orphans was our record!)
